

Chudleigh Film Society News

Our new Season continues with two screenings in November.

Firstly, the biographical drama, **Stan & Ollie** (Cert PG) (98min) on **8 November** in the Woodway Room of Chudleigh Town Hall (use main entrance - doors open approx 7.15pm for 8pm screening) is a 2018 screen adaptation of Laurel and Hardy's tour of British music halls in 1953. With their celebrity on the wane, it begins in fairly subdued fashion - but with the support of their formidable wives Lucille (Shirley Henderson) and Ida (Nina Arianda) and encouraged by their inimitable love of performing, they secure an enduring place in the hearts of the public as they head towards a big London finale. Steve Coogan and John C. Reilly give superb, charismatic performances as unmistakable screen comedians in this terrific new film, directed by Jon S. Baird.The film has also been kindly sponsored by two Chudleigh residents.

Subsequently, the biographical drama, **Woman in Gold** (Cert12A) 2015(109 min) on **29 November** at the same venue/time afore-mentioned is based on the remarkable true story of one woman's journey to reclaim her family's possessions some 60 years after they were seized by the Nazis in Vienna. Maria Altmann (Helen Mirren) takes her fight to the US Supreme Court, with the help of a plucky young lawyer (Ryan Reynolds), as the issue of ownership of a famous painting becomes the subject of a legal battle by its now legal owner.
